The Summer Work Practice program at Tassajara provides a wonderful opportunity for living and working within a community where the foundation is Zen meditation.

The focus of our practice in the summer is work. Life here requires a high degree of self-discipline and selfmotivation. At the same time, work practice offers many opportunities for studying the self, cultivating dharma relationships with other students and teachers, and practicing in a deeply supportive natural environment. Tassajara's work-practice approach is based on the teachings of Shunryu Suzuki Roshi.

In addition to gaining skills and practicing in the community, summer students can earn up to two practice period scholarships, which can be used at any of the San Francisco Zen Center temples for intensive periods of Zen practice.
